How to Prepare

Make sure each explorer participates in the competition (map creation, presentation and scoring). Adjust the pace of activity according to the skills of explorers. Motivate trying different map customization options. Based on the known background and time available, emphasize groupwide expectations. Help setting up the initial project and print out the maps. Award the winners.

Need to Emphasize

- Map creation is an art that is based on scientific data.
- It is relatively easy to see a good map.
- Trying different options can improve your creativity.
